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# INTRODUCTION

The Okavango Delta reaches into north-eastern Namibia to create one of southern Africa's most remarkable wilderness areas. Here, the seasonal floodwaters of the Okavango River spread across vast floodplains, reed-lined channels and riverine forests, supporting an extraordinary diversity of wildlife within a landscape that remains largely untouched. Often overlooked in favour of its Botswanan counterpart, this quieter corner of the Delta offers an intimate safari experience with exceptional photographic opportunities.

This safari explores the rich ecosystems of Nkasa Rupara National Park and the surrounding Kwando-Linyanti region, where elephants, buffalo, lion, leopard, wild dog and an abundance of birdlife thrive alongside the waterways. With exclusive access to a private concession and a small group of photographers, the itinerary is designed to maximise time in the field while allowing the flexibility to respond to changing light, wildlife behaviour and photographic opportunities.

From early mornings on the floodplains to late afternoons along the river channels, each day offers a different perspective on this dynamic landscape. The combination of open grasslands, papyrus-lined waterways and woodland habitats creates a diverse photographic environment where intimate wildlife encounters and dramatic landscape compositions are equally rewarding.

Led by C4 photographic guides Jandre Germishuizen and Darren Donovan, this safari has been designed for photographers wanting a more considered experience of Namibia's Delta region, combining expert photographic guidance with extended time in one of Africa's least-visited and most rewarding wetland ecosystems.

## DAY 1 - 2

**1 NIGHT**

Upon arrival at O.R. Tambo International Airport, make your way to City Lodge O.R. Tambo Airport for your overnight stay. The evening is yours to relax before the safari begins the following morning.

## DAY 2 - 8

**NKASA LINYANTI**

**6 NIGHTS**

After breakfast, depart Johannesburg on your scheduled flight to Kasane Airport. From here, continue by road into Namibia, travelling through the Caprivi before arriving at Nkasa Linyanti, your home for the next six nights.

Positioned within one of southern Africa's most remarkable wetland ecosystems, Nkasa Linyanti offers a quieter alternative to the Okavango Delta while supporting exceptional wildlife viewing. Open floodplains, winding waterways and riverine forests create a rich mosaic of habitats, attracting elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard, African wild dog and an abundance of birdlife throughout the year.

Over the coming days, enjoy flexible morning and afternoon game drives led by experienced local guides and C4 photographic guides. With a maximum of six guests across two vehicles, there is time to respond to changing light, wildlife behaviour and photographic opportunities as they unfold. Between activities, relax at camp, review your images or simply enjoy the surroundings of this remote wilderness.

After breakfast, transfer by road to Kasane Airport for your scheduled flight back to Johannesburg, where your safari comes to an end.

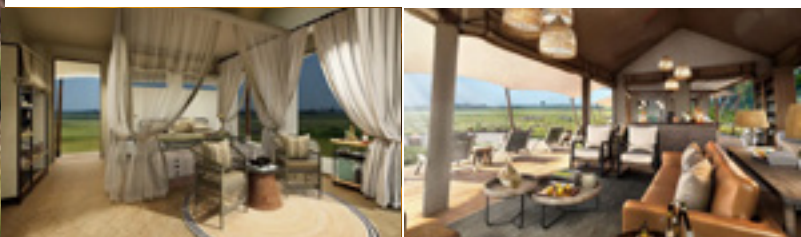

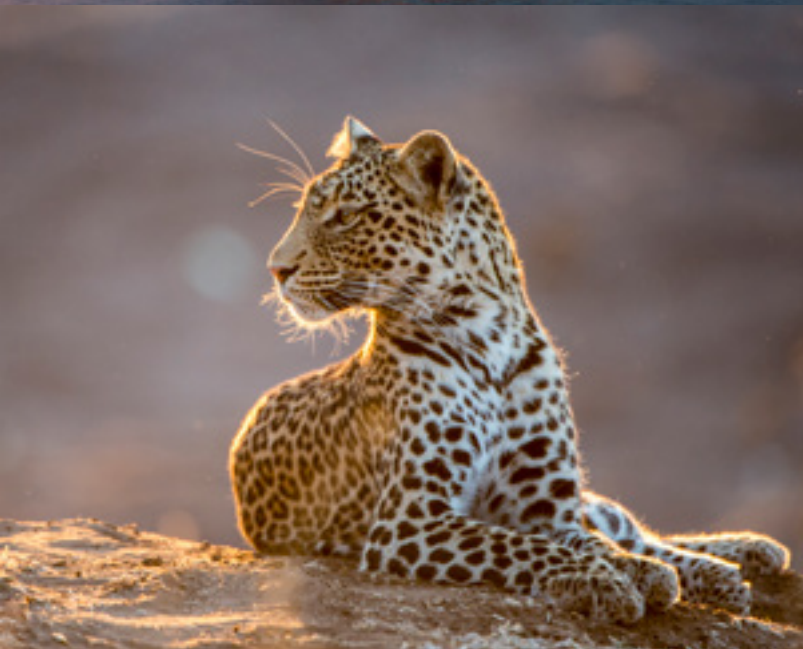
## NKASA LINYANTI
